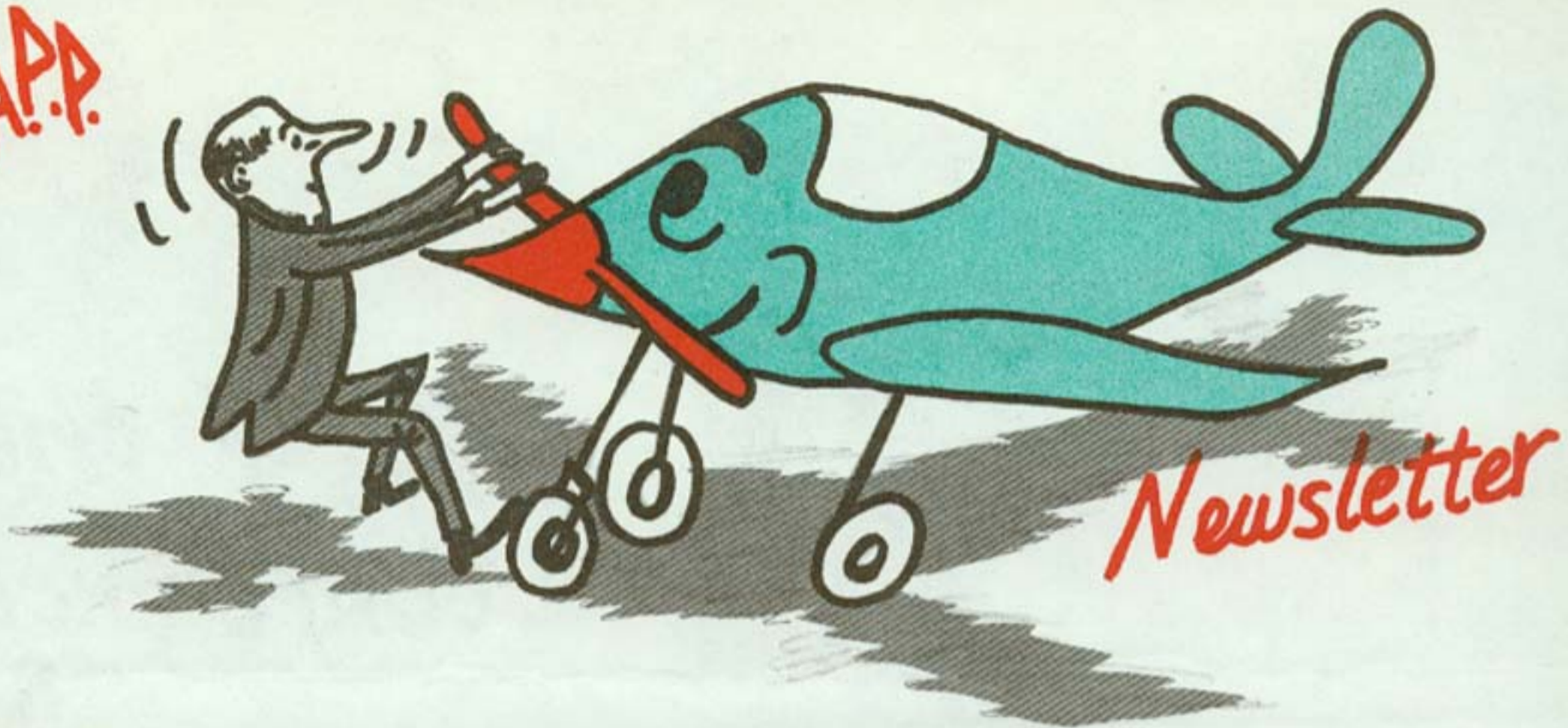

On Thursday evening, November 19, the NAPP Board of Directors held a telephone conference to discuss and make some decisions for the organization. Several of these decisions will become effective with this newsletter.

Decision number one is an effort to establish our fiscal year from January 1 through December 31. There has been much confusion in this area since our founding. This arose from the fact that the Charter members paid their dues in August at the first convention and continued to pay each year at this time. Members who joined later were considered as having paid January 1. This method of dues payment presented the treasurer with members paying at two different times of the year.

Beginning January 1, 1971 our year begins on this date. Consequently, you will find the dues notice for 1971 in this newsletter. We ask that you send your 1971 membership dues as soon as possible. This will be a tremendous help to those of us burdened with the clerical and bookkeeping chores of your organization.

Our records show that a number of the Priests listed in the 1970 NAPP directory have not paid dues—some for a number of years. The moment of reckoning must eventually come in any organization and the Board says, "No dues; no membership." However, the past NAPP policy of offering membership to any Priest unable to pay the dues will be continued.

Enclosed with this newsletter is a card we would ask that you return. It should be self explanatory. There will be another final reminder in the February newsletter. Those who fail to respond by March 1 will be considered "not interested" and their names removed from the files.

Several other items discussed dealt with the inner workings and communications among the Board members. These were ironed out and the remainder of the conference dealt with convention plans-1971.

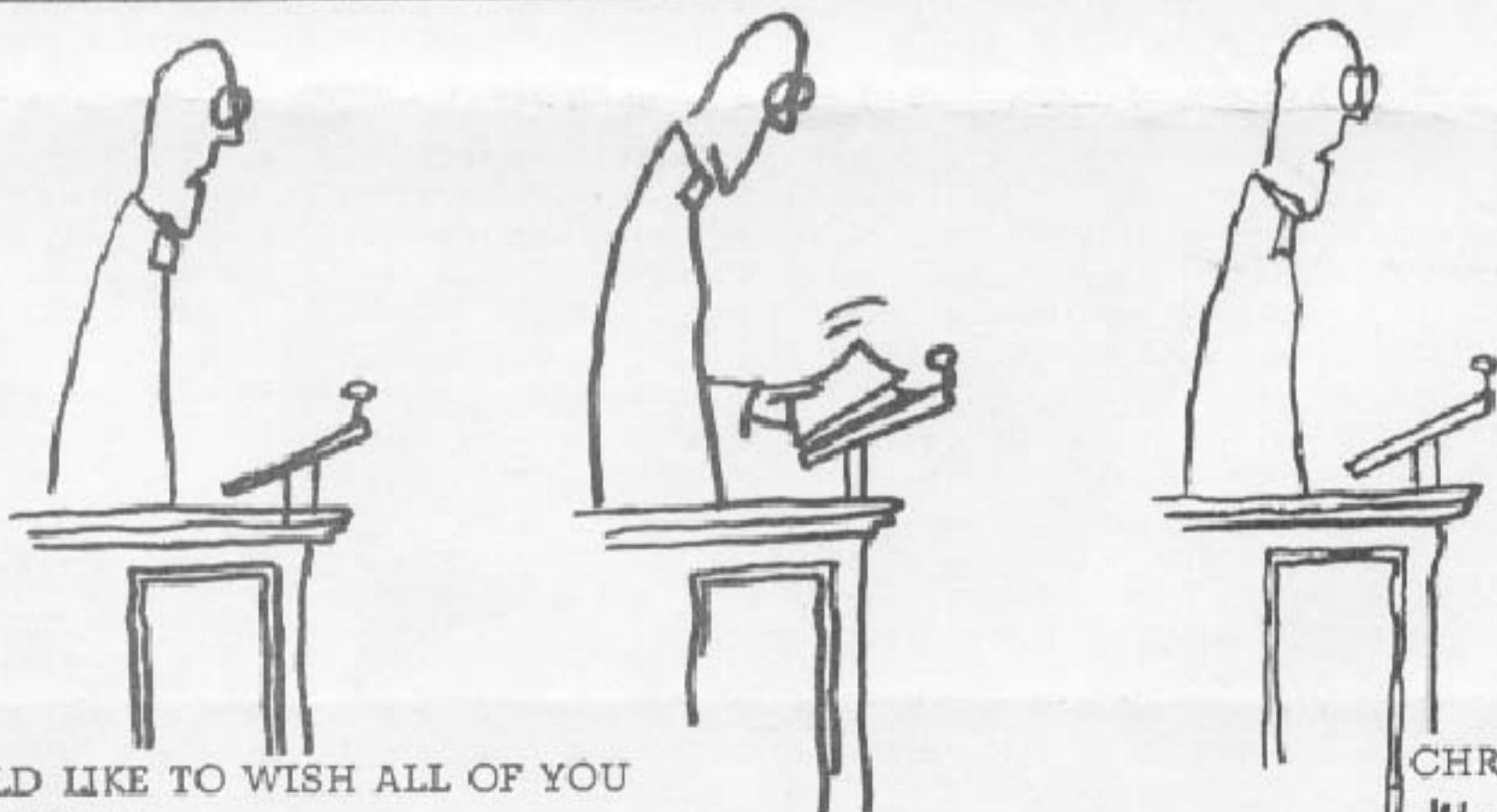
Jack Dompka announced that Pittsburg has been selected as the 1971 site. The dates are July 12-14. More information and details will be coming later.
