

- 1). The first of these is the Midwest Regional gathering in La Crosse, Wisconsin hosted by John Swing on May 9<sup>th</sup>. John has finalized the program for the day and the newly revised registration form enclosed has all the particulars. Please note that because of the Mississippi boat cruise the ETA will have to be a little earlier than usual. Please plan accordingly when notifying John of your plans when registering for the day(s).
- 2). A little fine tuning puts the final touches on the 2011 National Convention in Clear Lake, Iowa. That schedule, along the information sheet that was also in the last newsletter, gives you a good overview of the planned program. As happens each year the gathering offers events unique to the local area.

**2 VP:** Allen Corrigan **Secretary:** Phil Gibbs



Hello Mel.

I am doing well. I was pastor at Gesu Parish in Milwaukee for seven years. I enjoyed it, but felt it was time to leave. We experienced an embezzlement that resulted in almost \$1 million walking out the door (discovered six months into my term...had been going on for years).
