Mooney: "Departure, this is Mooney 1MN climbing on runway heading."



The information sheet is once again included in the newsletter, along with a registration form. John asks that you send the registration form to him so that planning can be properly taken care of.


There is also a brochure from our place of residence, the AmericInn. As the information sheet indicates you are expected to make your own room reservations. A block of rooms is reserved for NAPP


